Prices and Opening Times

With lots to explore at Sandringham please ensure you plan your day beforehand. We recommend a minimum of 3.5 hours to ensure you get the most out of your visit, longer if you can.

Please read all the information before completing and returning the booking form to the Visitor Enterprises Administrator.

All group visits must be pre-booked and are based on a minimum of 20 people, prices are per person and are inclusive of VAT. Your group will therefore be charged for a minimum of 20 people.

Group admission to the House is available at 10.30am, 11.30am, 12.30pm, 1.30pm, 2.30pm and 3.30pm. Multimedia Guides can be hired at a cost for £5 each.

Sandringham accepts a maximum of 3 coaches per morning and 3 coaches per afternoon, Monday - Friday during the main season from April - October.

How to get to Sandringham

By Road

Sandringham is 6 miles north-east of King's Lynn and is signposted from the A148 Fakenham road and the A149 Hunstanton road.

Newer sat nav systems should recognise the Royal Park's postcode of PE35 6AB.

Parking

Free coach parking is available in the Royal Parkland with the exception of certain event days, when parking may be charged and in different locations across the Estate.

Accessibility

The House is accessible by wheelchair and a buggy service operates between the Gardens and House entrances.

Wheelchairs are available on loan subject to availability.

Assistance dogs are admitted into all facilities including the House. Visit our website to read our full access statement.

1. Complete and return the booking form to group.bookings@sandringhamestate.co.uk or please post.
2. Upon receipt of your booking form, arrangements will be made for your group and a confirmation email will be sent to you.
3. Pre-booked group tickets must be paid for by credit card, bank transfer (BACS) or cheque payable to 'Sandringham Estate' 30 days before the visit date. A pro-forma invoice will be sent when numbers are confirmed.
4. Please note our kitchens can cater for vegetarian Afternoon Tea but we are unable to offer gluten free, dairy free or vegan options.

Please consider how much time is needed for your visit, groups may sometimes leave disappointed as the organisers have not anticipated enough time. You **must** arrive 60 minutes before your House timed entry.

Terms and Conditions.

All visits to Sandringham **must** be pre-booked to guarantee entry to the House and Gardens, groups are parties of 20 or more people so you will be charged the minimum payment of £500 for less than 20 people for a Classic Group Visit or £900 for a Private Guided Tour. All guided tours and catering requirements are subject to availability. Booking forms and payment must be received no less than 30 days prior to the visit date. Tickets are non-refundable.

All prices and opening times are subject to change. Sandringham Estate reserves the right to close at short notice or change any of its opening times and events or to restrict or refuse access at any time without notice.

Coach parking is free for all pre-booked coaches.
